And when the Last Day comes, we shall be judged from this, and on this basis, we shall receive the eternal verdict." (Diarv. 1155-1158) If there is someone in your life that needs mercy from youoffer mercy! If there are circumstances that have hurt, you- offer mercy! If you are alienated and ignored by others who ought to know better- offer mercy! If criticism and judgment is all you receive from others- offer mercy!
